Explain any five teacher’s code of conduct with students. Argue whether or not the code of conduct for teachers will promote dignity and honour to the teaching profession.

Define professional attitude and professional conduct in your own words. Justify teaching as a professional activity within the cultural context of Bhutan. (5+15=20 marks)

Differentiate between NAPE and the traditional method of teaching. Explain the impact of NAPE education in our country. (10+10=20 marks)

The importance of information and communication technology (ICT) has been recognized and incorporated into the school curriculum. How would this measure contribute to quality learning outcome in Bhutanese children? (20 marks)

Trace the history of education system in Bhutan and explain the purpose of expanding the Monastic education and English education in the country. (20 marks)
