

1. Name of the Competition: Excellent Teacher Innovator
2. Target groups: 4th Years preservice student teachers (B.Ed Pzy and B. Ed Dzo)
3. Brief description of the competition:

The overarching theme for Excellent Teacher Innovator is required to produce digital resources or products using innovative ideas that you have learned from first to final year. This is class-wise competition. Each class must come-up with three products as given below. The thematic innovative learning product will focus on three areas. Using technology, each class must come with **three products (one product** in each area)

1. Sexual Comprehensive Education: The student teacher needs to design infographic based on the following themes:
 - a. Sexual Harassment
 - b. Sexual Violence
2. Dzongkha - The student teacher needs to design the digital poster or one page digital comic based on the following themes:
 - a. Preservation of Cultural values
 - b. Lozay, Tsangmo, stories, poems, etc.
3. STEM - The student teacher needs to design documentary movie based on the following themes:
 - a. Co-creation of knowledge and application in community settings.

The tentative submission of the final product is on **11th June 2022**. There will be a grand exhibition of your products. A mixture of external and internal evaluators will assess your products. Members must be available to explain about them.

The student teachers will be awarded a cash prize and certificate.

First Prize: Nu 8000/-

Second Prize: Nu 6000/-

Third: Nu 4000/-
